## A170 Helmsley - Linkfoot Lane Email received 3rd December 2021 - Traffic Speeds

I can advise you that the A170 has previously been assessed by North Yorkshire Police Traffic Bureau.

The information obtained resulted in us taking the decision to enforce the area with one of our Safety Camera vehicles.

Enforcement is undertaken at times as identified by the data. Please note, enforcement may be restricted by weather conditions, daylight saving times, and certain sites may also be limited by parking space.

Due to the large number of sites in the area requiring enforcement, the limited number of vehicles available and the on-going Coronavirus situation, our safety camera officers have been unable to visit sites as frequently as we would perhaps like.

I have, however, passed on your concerns to our safety camera deployment team so that this site can be considered for enforcement again in the near future.

Please note, the primary aim of the 95 Alive initiative and the Speed Management Protocol is the enforcement of existing speed limits.

Changes in speed limit, the implementation of additional road signage or further road engineering (such as speed bumps/chicanes) are decisions made at the discretion of your local authority or council.
